Tools & Equipment Use, Operation, & Repair

Davis and MassX purchase quality tools and equipment for workers to use on the job sites. As a requirement workers are to use these tools as the manufacturer intended. Power tools are very common to any construction site. Using equipment and tools for purpose other than what it's designed for is prohibited. OSHA states that workers must operate equipment and tools according to the manufacturer's instructions.



Employees are also required as part of their job description to maintain and protect these from damage. We all know that the construction field is hard on tools and equipment but workers can do their part in using tools properly, maintaining for use, and storing the tools so it doesn't get damaged. When tools get damaged only qualified personnel should make repairs and most of the time this means the manufacturer.

DO NOT PERFORM "MAKE SHIFT" REPAIRS ON TOOLS.

Our Safety Policy states:

"Employees are prohibited from making repairs, alterations, or attachments to equipment in the field except by the permission of the superintendent, foreman, or equipment mechanic. Only qualified personnel will perform repairs on equipment. Such repairs, alterations, or attachments are documented on the appropriate shop forms. Employees are prohibited from removing a guard, safety device, or appliance from equipment or machinery except to make repairs. While making repairs, employees use appropriate lockout/tagout procedures. When repairs are complete the guard, safety device, or appliance is replaced immediately."

Inspect your tools, and if you have a piece of equipment or tool that is broken, point it out to a Foreman or Supervisor and get it repaired.
